PART 1 - Admissions to the 2026/2027 school year

Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2026/2027

The following are the dates applicable for admission to First Year

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	1st October 2025
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	1st November 2025
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	1st December 2025
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	21 days from date of offer e.g. 21st Dec 2025

***Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn**

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Special Class Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2026/2027

The following are the dates applicable for admission to the school's Special Class which caters for children with Austistic Spectrum Disorder

The school will commence accepting applications for admission to the special class on	1st October 2025
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission to the special class on	1st November 2025
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application for admission to the special class is	1st December 2025
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	21 days from date of offer e.g. 21st Dec 2025

***Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn**

New Criterion in compliance with NCSE guidance states:

Applicants to the special class must be known to the NCSE and have the NCSE letter confirming their eligibility for the special class or special school. This new criterion will take effect from 2026/2027 onwards. For example, regarding a special class for autism, the following must be provided in support of an application for admission:

Professional report(s) outlining:

- Diagnosis of Autism: DSM IV/V or ICD 10/11 – this is a psychologist, psychiatrist, multidisciplinary report
- A demonstration of the understanding of complexity of the child's overall level of need/s evidenced in the professional reports
- Given the severity or complexity of the child's support needs, a clear professional recommendation and rationale as to what educational placement type would be most appropriate to best meet the child's needs
- A letter from the NCSE confirming that the child is known to them and that the child has the required diagnosis and recommendation for a special class for autism
